W.172. (Widow: Hannah) Solomon died Nov. 4, 1833

Declaration.

In order to obtain the benefit of the Act of Congress of the 7th of June, 1832.
State of Maine.

Kennebec County SS

On this tenth day of August A.D. 1832 personally appeared before the Hon. Nathan Weston, Jun'r, a Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court, of said State, Solomon Adams, a resident of Farmington in the County of Kennebec and State of Maine, aged seventy three years, and eight months who being first duly sworn, according to law, doth on his oath make the following declaration, in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the Act of Congress, passed June 7, 1832.

That he enlisted in the Army of the United States in the year 1777 with Captain Varnum and served in Col. Michael Jacksons' regiment of the Massachusetts line or troops under the following named officers: Varnum Capt Jackson Colonel.

That in May 1777 he enlisted in that company and regiment as a private for the term of three years. That under that enlistment, he continued to serve until January 4, 1780, when having procured a substitute to the acceptance of his colonel, he was honorably discharged, and that his discharge is hereunto annexed.

That he was at the taking of Burgoyne, and in the battle of Bemis' Heights.

That on account of his property, he made no application under the act of March 18, 1818.

He hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension or an annuity, except the present, and he declares that his name is not on the Pension Roll of any agency in any State. (Signed) Solomon Adams.
