

Pension Application for Ezra Allen

On this 14th say of February A.D. 1820 before me the subscriber one of the Judges of the County Court of the County aforesaid personally appears Ezra Allen of Cornwall in said County, aged sixty one years, who being by me first duly sworn, according to law, doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provision made by the act of Congress entitled “an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land & naval service of the Unites States in the revolutionary War”.

That he the said Ezra Allen enlisted in the Town of New Marlboro; State of Massachusetts sometime in the fore part of July 1779 into the service of the United States for the term of nine months, and, on the 22d day of the same month joined the army at, or near, a place then called Salem in the State of Newyork [New York] near Connecticut line, and was attached to a company commanded by Capt Noah attached to a company commanded by Capt Noah Allen of the 10th Massachusetts Regiment which regiment he thinks, was then commanded by Colo Sprout. That he continued to serve in said Regiment until the 22d day of April 1780, when he was honorably discharged from service at the Highlands in the State of Newyork, which discharge he has now in his possession, (and is transmitted herewith) and that he is in reduced circumstances and stands in need of the assistance of his country for support.
