

Pension Application for William Allen

I, William Allen of Crosbytown in the County of Penobscot Yeoman, do hereby testify & say, that on the 12th day of January, 1777, I inlisted into the service of the United States in Cap George Whites Company & Col. Benj'n Tuppers Regt., & Pattersons Brigadier for [?] three years Regt., & Pattersons Brigade for three years. I served this time out and received an Honorable discharge at West Point on the 12th day of January 1780 as will appear by the inclosed Certificates.

My Discharge has been since lost. I am now under reduced circumstances & need the assistance of my Country for support.

I hereby relinquish all claim to any previous Pension for my said services. Witness my hand. (Signed) Wm Allen Dated April 9, 1818.

[Note: this man's discharge is in his folder, and so is his commission.]
