

Pension Application for Daniel Alvoord

On this 18 day of May 1818, before me the subscriber, one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas of the County of Madison aforesaid, personally appears Daniel Alvord aged 60 years, resident I Georgetown in the said county, who being by me first duly sworn, according to law, doth, on his oath, make the following declaration, in order to obtain he provision made by the late act of Congress, entitled "An act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the revolutionary war;"

That he the said Daniel³ Alvord enlisted in Oct 1775 in the state of Massachusetts in the company commanded by captain Jonathan Allen of the 17 Regiment commanded by Colo Ward, Massachusetts line that he continued to serve in said corps, or in the U. States until the first of Jany 1777, when

He was discharged from service in Pekersill [Peekskill?] state of New York, that he was in the battles of Long Island, and that he is in reduced circumstances, and stands in need of the assistance of his country for support; and that he has no other evidence now in his power of said services.
