

**Pension Application for Baptist or Charles Amelin or Amlin**

W.20640 (Widow: Agathe) Married 1778. [Marriage document in French.] He died July 3, 1820.

I, Charles Amlin one of the Canadian Refugees now of the town of Plattsburgh in the County of Clinton & Sate of New York do solemnly & sincerely swear & declare that I was a private in the company commanded by Captain Oliver in the Regiment commanded by Col Hasen [Hazen] called one of the Congress regiments in the service of the United States of America on the Continental establishment in the war of the revolution.

That I enlisted at Montreal in the same regiment for the term of one year in the spring of the year 1776 when the army under the command of General Montgomery returned from Quebec and that at the end of the year I enlisted again for the war, at Albany and served in the whole about seven years & was discharged at New Windsor in the State of New York in the spring if 1783. My discharge I lost about seven years since, and that by reason of my reduced circumstances in life am in need of assistance from my country for support. (Signed with his mark) Charles Amlin.
