Amsden, Silas

His name appears on the list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the District of Massachusetts, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on April 25, 1794, and printed in the American State Papers, class 9, page 87.

Rank: Private

Regt: 2d Massachusetts

Disability: Wounded in the left knee by a sled load of wood running over it, which he was drawing for the use of the garrison at West Point, which wound has never been cured, and in all probability never will.

When and where disabled: 1783, West Point Resident: South Borough.

To what pension entitled: Full pension.

Remarks: discharged September 17, 1783.
