

**Pension Application for Lilburn Andrews**

W.20618 (Widow: Sarah) Sarah Huse married Lilburn Andrews on March 22, 1789. He died November 12, 1838.

I Lilburn Andrews now of Lime in the Township of Grafton in the State of New Hampshire do testify and declare that by voluntary enlistment, I entered into the service of the United States in the Spring of the year 1781 in the first company in the sixth Regiment in the Massachusetts line of the Continental army in the war of the Revolution that I enlisted in the Town of Andover in the State of Massachusetts that I joined the Regiment the same season there at West Point. That I faithfully served as a private soldier in said Company for two years and upward even until the close of the war at which time I received a regular and honorable discharge which by reason of the length of time and accident I have lost & am not now able to produce. That I ever have been & now a resident citizen of the United States and that by reason of my reduced circumstances in life I am in need of the Countrys assistance for support and I do now relinquish all claim to any pension that may heretofore have been allowed to me by the Laws of the United States.
