

Pension Application for Nathaniel Arnold

I Nathaniel Arnold, now of Bath, in the County of Lincoln and State of Main—do further upon oath declare that I served one year in Co. Graton's Regiment of the Massachusetts line from June 1780 to June 1781, and was honorably discharged at West Point in the State of New York—my said discharge was burnt in my house at Lancaster in Massachusetts; my house and all my furniture was consumed in 1808 and I soon afterwards removed with my family from Massachusetts to Maine, in which latter State I have resided ever since—I am now upwards of seventy three years of age, poor and destitute, have been supported by the town as a pauper by the said town of Bath during the last year. Resided at Augusta Maine for the years 1826 & 1827. I was well acquainted with my Capt. Newcomb, he belonged at Braintree, in the County of Norfolk, Massachusetts, but has long since deceased.
