

Pension Application for Daniel Ashley

I Silas Stow first Judge of the Court of Com. Pleas in and for the County of Lewis do certify that on the 28th day of August 1819 Daniel Ashley now of Martinsburg in said county, but formerly of Hadley in the state of New York, being duly sworn by me, did depose and say—

That he was a native of Sheffield in Massachusetts & that he was sixty years old—

That at the age of Eighteen he enlisted into the army of the United States in the Massachusetts line,--Gen. [Larneel's?] Brigade, Col. Weston's Regiment in Capt. Bartlet's Compy, then commanded by Lieut Caleb Noble for nine months.

That he served the said nine months, and was honourably discharged—He served generally near White Plains and was discharged at Fishkill.

That in the burning of his dwelling house he thinks his discharge was consumed.

He further disposes and says that he has no other document in his possession relative to this application. And that by reason of his reduced circumstances in life, he stands in need of assistance from his country for support. Daniel Ashley
