On this 25th day of April A.D. 1818 before me the subscriber one of the Judges of the Court of Common pleas for said county personally appears Theodore Atkinson aged fifty three years resident in the Town of Sandwich County and State aforesaid who being by me first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provision made by the late act of Congress entitled An act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the revolutionary war.

That he the said Theodore Atkinson in April 1781 enlisted in the Town of Sandwich in said State for three years in the company commanded by Captain John Blanchard, Colo Henry Jacksons Regiment Massachusetts line that he continued to serve in said service of the United States in said war on the Continental Establishment from April 1781 until December 1783 when he was discharged at a place called the York Hutts near West Point in the State of New York he then had a discharge which he has since lost and has no reason to believe that it is now in existence that he was in the battle at Yorktown in 1781 and that he is in reduced circumstances and stands in need of the assistance of his country for support.
