

Pension Application for Jarib Bacon

On the 17th day of April in the year of our Lord 1818 before me the subscriber one of the Judges of the court of common pleas of the County of Genesee in the State of New York, personally appeared Jarib Bacon aged sixty nine years resident in the County of Ontario in the State aforesaid who being by me first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provision made by the late act of Congress entitled an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War.

That he the said Jarib Bacon enlisted on the tenth day of March in the year of our Lord 1777 as a private in the town of Brookfield in the State of Massachusetts in the company commanded by Capt Speer in a Regiment under command of Colonel Nixon in the Massachusetts line. That he continued to serve in the said corps or in the service of the United States until the eleventh day of March in the year 1780 when he was discharged from service at or near West Point in the State of New York.

That he was in no regular battle during his said service and that he is in reduced circumstances and stands in need of assistance from his country for support, and that he has no other evidence now in his power of his said services. (Signed) Jarib Bacon
