

Pension Application for Ebenezer Bailey

R.395 (Widow: Tryphena) Married November 5, 1795 Ebenezer married the widow Tryphena Coe. March 6, 1798, Abijah was born.

State of Connecticut

County of Middlesex SS.

Haddton, May 15th 1855.

On the fifteenth day of May personally appeared before me, Isaac Arnold, Judge of the probate Court for the district of Haddan (she not being able on account of infirmity to appeared in open court, Triphena Bailey aged eighty nine years, who being duly sworn, according to law doth on her oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the pensions of any act or acts of Congress that would entitle her to benefit on account of being the widow of a Revolutionary Soldier.

That she is the widow of Ebenezer Bailey who was a private in the War of the Revolution. That he enlisted into Capt. Fish's company of the Second Regiment of the New York Continental Line, on the thirteenth (13th) day of August A.D. Seventeen Hundred and Seventy Seven to serve during the War and that he mustered to January Seventeen Hundred and Eighty Two. She also applies for any arrears which she is entitled to, as will appear from the above service and proofs.

She further declares that she was married to the said Ebenezer Bailey on the Fifth day of November the year seventeen hundred and ninety five, that her husband the aforesaid Ebenezer Bailey died on the sixth day of June A.D. eighteen hundred and twenty eight.

That she was not married to him prior to his leaving the service, but the marriage took place previous to the second day of January eighteen hundred: viz: at the time above stated. She further stated and swears, that she is now a widow and has remained so ever since the death of her said husband and that she has never before made any application for a pension as the friend that volunteered to investigate the claim did not understand the business.

Sworn to and subscribed or made her mark on the day and year above written to wit, on the fifteenth day of May A.D. eighteen hundred and fifty five before me. (Signed with her mark) Tryphena Bailey
