

Pension Application for Aaron Baldwin

On this 15th day of October personally appeared in open court before the Judges of the said court now sitting & being a court of record, Aaron Baldwin a resident of the town of Westford in the County & State aforesaid aged seventy one years on the 21st day of February 1832 who being first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the act of Congress passed June 7, 1832.

That he was drafted for nine months & entered the service of the United States in the Continental Army on or about the first day of April in the year 1778 or 1779 & this deponent cannot tell which & that he was discharged about the first day of January following but has lost his discharge & has no other documentary evidence except what is herewith transmitted. That this deponent at the time he entered the service lived in the Town of Cornwall Litchfield County & State of Connecticut. That the Capt. of his company was a Mr. Woodbridge in Colo. Swifts Regt & Genl Huntington's Brigade. That subsequently to this service of the said this deponent with several others was ordered out on service & proceeded to Stratford on Long Island Sound in Connecticut for the term of 3 months when he was dismissed & returned home until he volunteered in the New York State troops for nine months in the year 1782 & was attached to a Regt commanded by Col. Wisenfeld at Fishkill in the State of New York & this deponent soon after entered the Artillery troops at West Point under the command of Capt. Moody in Col. Lamb's Regt & remained there until he was discharged in January following when he returned home.

He hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension or annuity except the present & declares that his name is not on any pension roll of the agency of any state.
