

Pension Application for Daniel Barker

I Daniel Barker of Exeter in the County of Penobscot aged sixty four do hereby testify & say that on or about the first of January 1776, I inlisted [enlisted] into the Continental Service, in Capt Isaac Sherman's Company. Col. Baldwins Regt & Putman Brigade (according to my recollection) for one year. I joined my Regt at [Picks Kitts? Peekskill?]: marched to Kings Ferry & Fishkill, where I was discharged on or about the first of January 1777. Having served out my time of one years. I am now under reduced circumstances & need the assistance of my Country for support. I never had a written discharge; nor had any of your Company.

In a previous affidavit of a similar tenor & date I stated from my best Recollection, that I inlsited [enlisted] in the month of September 1776. I have since been into the State of N. Hampshire, where I have seen some of the soldiers belonging to this same company & who have since been placed on the Pension list, whose Depositions I now inclose & find I was incorrect in my former statement & now make my Affidavit as corrected by such information as I have collected from Two of my fellow soldiers.
