

Pension Application for Cornelius Bartlett

I Cornelius Bartlett of Westhampton in the County of Hampshire and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, testify and say, that on the first day of May 1777, I enlisted as a soldier under Captain Jonathan Allen in Colo Rufus Putnams Regiment and General Nixons Brigade on the Continental establishment and was transferred into Capt Goodales company in the above Regiment and Brigade and served in Captain Goodales Company until December 1780 at which time I was discharged at Westpoint in the State of New York, which discharge is lost. I have never received any pension from the Government, and from my reduced circumstances I am in need of assistance from my County for support and am now fifty six years of age. (Signed) Cornelius Bartlet. May 5th 1818.
