

Pension Application for Jonah Bartow

Pleas before the Honorable Judges of the Court of Common Pleas at Norwalk within the for the County of Huron State of Ohio in the term of October Anno Domini, eighteen hundred and twenty. Jonah Bartow oath decl'r & schedule for pension.

State of Ohio

Huron County SS.

On this 31st day of October 1820 personally appeared in open court being a court of record by the laws of the State of Ohio, and known as the Court of Common Pleas in and for the County of Huron and State of Ohio Jonah Bartow aged fifty nine years, resident in said county who being first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath declare that he served in the Revolutionary War as follows.

That he enlisted in the fifth Regiment New York Continental establishment commanded by Col. Dubois in a company commanded by Capt. Beavere in the late part of the month of April in the year 1779 to serve during the Continuance of the war and continued to serve in the New York Line of Continental establishment until the 8th day of June 1783 at which time he received his discharge at Newburgh New York which said discharge was forwarded to the Secretary of War in the year 1819 that he made declaration on the twenty sixth day of May 1818 and application to be placed on the pension list roll and receive a certificate of his being placed on the pension list dated 30th day of November 1819 No. 15986—and I do solemnly swear that I was a resident citizen of the United States on the 18th day of March 1818 and that I have not since that time by gift sale or in any manner disposed of my property or any part thereof with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of an act of Congress entitled an act of provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War passed on the 18th day of March 1818 and that I have not nor any person for me any property or securities contracts or debts due to me nor have I any income other than what is contained in the schedule hereunto annexed and by me subscribed.

--one pork bbl fifty cents thirty pounds pork on dollar and eighty seven cents ten bushels corn three dollars and seventy five cents three bushels potatoes seventy five cents tobacco not manufactured suppose ten pounds one dollar one tobacco box twelve cents one jack knife twenty five cents demand on David Gibbs Esqr.
