Wm Shephard on the Continental Establishment in the 4th Massachusetts Regiment that in June sometime about the third from river at different places and on different military services that he was under the M Delafayette at the capture of Corn Wallace from thence to West Point and after suffering privations move them the can now desernbe? He at the close of the war was honorably discharged at Orange town and further that his health is very infirm that he owns no real estate and no other property except one Cow and a few sheep and a small supply Household Furniture and that he is in need of assistance from his country.
