Personally appeared before me Harry Garrison one of the Judges of said County, Jacob Bennett, Sixty Nine years who being sworn deposed & saith that he entered the service of the United [States] in the year 1775 in a company commanded by Capt. John Lamb in the Artillery and went to Cannada & was at the storming of Quebeck was there taken prisner [prisoner] & remain in jail there nine months & sent from there by water to New York & was there exchanged. I then reinlisted [reenlisted] under Cap. Titus in Col. Wisenfelt's Rigement [Regiment] for and during the war was after some time transferred from said Wisenfelts Rigement to Col. Cortlandt Rigiment and in a company commanded by Capt. Hamtramick and I ser'd till the end of the war and was Honorably Discharge from said Rigement by Col. Philip VanCortlandt in the year 1783. Just back of Newburgh in the State of New York. (Signed) Jacob Bennet
