

### **Disability for Abraham Blauvelt**

Disability

Blauvelt, Abraham

His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the District of New York, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on May 22, 1794, and printed in the American State Papers, class 9, page 126.

Rank: Private

Regt: Lieut Colonel Cooper's militia.

Disability: Wounded by a bayonet in his breast, and by a ball in his left thigh, and otherwise hurt, in an action with the enemy.

When and where disabled: October 1778, Orangetown

Residence; Orange County.

Remarks: No rolls in the office.
