Declaration. In order to obtain the benefit of the third section of the act of Congress of the 4th July 1836.

County of Dutchess SS.

On this eighteenth day of December 1843 personally appeared before the subscriber of Fishkill Town in said County, First Judge of the Court in and for said county Rachel Bogardus of the Town of Fishkill in said county according to law, doth on her oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the act of Congress passed July 4th 1836.

That she is the widow of Henry Bogardus late of Dutchess County & of Fishkill a soldier in the war of the Revolution, that her said husband the aforesaid Henry Bogardus enlisted in the nine months service, this deponent recollects the name of Col. Wisenfit & thinks he was the Col., that during the nine months Maj Andric was taken and executed, that he was one of the guard at the execution & one of the guard at the grave the night after the execution, that some of her aforesaid husband's companions were in service in the same company & regiment & in his men were Andrew Dolleway, John Cagin or name or names very much like them, that her said husband was in other service, that after her marriage was in the service in the war of the Revolution, under Col. Wisenfeld, that he served under many officers the names of which this deponent cannot be positive, but believes he was in the service two years or more & may have been in three years, he was a resident of Fishkill.

She further declares that she was married to the aforesaid Henry Bogardus in February 1781 seventeen hundred & eighty one & that her aforesaid husband was in the service after her said marriage to him, that her husband the aforesaid Henry Bogardus died upwards of twenty years since & that she has not since married.
