

Pension Application for Joseph Bohan

Joseph Bohan, Captain Pulaskis Legion.
Georgia SS.

On the 24th day of July personally appeared in open Court the same being a Court of record to wit, the Mayor's Court of the City of Augusta in the County of Richmond & State aforesaid, Joseph Bohan aged sixty five years, resident in the state of Georgia & City aforesaid, who first being sworn according to Law does on his oath declare that she served as a Captain in the revolutionary war as will appear on reference to deponants affidavit & application for a pension now in the office of the department of war, at Washington City & under which deponent hath heretofore received a pension & I do solemnly swear that I was a resident Citizen of the United States on the 18th day of March 1818 & that I have not since that time by gift sale or in any other manner disposed of my property or any part thereof with intention thereby to diminish it so as to bring myself within the act of Congress—entitled an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the Land & Naval Service of the United States in the revolutionary war passed on the 18th day of March 1818 & that I have not nor has any person in trust for me any property securities, Contracts or Debts due to me nor have I any income other than that contained in a Schedule hereto annexed & by me Subscribed. (Signed) Joseph Bohan

It is Considered by the Court no here in session that the property of the said Joseph Bohan is worth five dollars as appears by proof. Nicholas Ware. l Mayor & Judge of the Mayors Court City of Augusta Georgia.

Honorbl W.M. Stewart: I Joseph Bohan Regrestet Mr. Cobb to got main Land Warrant for Pevolutionary Servcies and he departed to me, that y warrVanndet by Col. Tarleton himself, and wars destroyed for funder service; withs is a mistake. &c

I received the Wornt from one of Tarleton Dragons in Sating Tree at one time in the Manner I now will relet. In Scouting I left main Company in the woods and I providet armnt of Tih, wan all at wars Tree Tarleton's Dragend rorosset on me unavare, with I Fanoriet and one of them whom behin me, and Rot me tru main Cass, and iron Cros in par kot [caught?] main thath, with met me sink on van saith of the horse, and in an insteng main Laftanent has name wars Prefnel main Countryman Polander Kam to main assistance, and kill the vere Mann he Kot me, and I recovered on main Sattle, and we took two presners, [prisoners?] and Tree [three?] horses. I wars put in hospital by order of main general Pulaski, and after I Recoveret gaint main company Dragoners at that time, wan [was] general Arnold the Trayter [traitor] Comandet Fort West Point, land Major Andre wars taka and we Condernt him as a spy, and I was parasent with main Company Starsse and so I constinuet durong the

Warr in Continental Service and wars at Little York in Virginia, and France and we took Coranwallis this of [?] and than I wars Discahrgt.

I waars born in Poland main Fathers hat only one son, and one doyer, Dogher, he send me in Latten Schol, Minsit and Fanting Schol, wan General Count Pulaski Khan to me and persuadet me, saaring we lart one contry and libert gavn me, and let us go to America. Main Father being death living me gut Property, land live main mother. In hardiet and cham to a Revolution left main mother Lester, and main property all behind, and Polaski, lovins his Somnla put oners Selfor [?] over General [?] Georgia Wasshinton.
