

Disability for Henry Bouce

Bouce, Henry

His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the District of New York, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on April 25, 1794, and printed in the American State Papers, class 9, page 92.

Rank: Private

Regt: Col. Willett's

Disability: Wounded in the side in an engagement with the Indians.

When and where disabled: June 1781, Tourlock.

Residence: Watervliet, Albany.

Remarks: This man is mustered in the New York line.

Evidence transmitted by the District Court complete.
