On the 13 day of January one thousand eight hundred and thirty two personally came before me Abraham Tanner one of the Justices of the Pease [Peace] of said county Seth Bouton and made oath that he was a soldier in the Revolutionary War that he searved [served] in war about fore [four] years in [Cladron?] service made a prisoner [prisoner] in New Yourk [York] that he served in Capt. Samuel Lewis Compt, Col. Thomas Redymet and was exchanged from prisonment [imprisonment] by Thomas Skinner. (Signed) Seth Bouton.
