

### **Pension Application for Reuben Brainard**

Not much in this file and what is there, is not legible.

W.3763 (Widow: Hannah) Reuben died March 15<sup>th</sup> 1798.

Letter in folder dated August 13, 1924, written in response to an inquiry.

I have to advise you that from the papers in Revolutionary War pension claim, W.3763, it appears that Reuben Brainard was born September 11, 1763.

He enlisted at Spencer, Tioga County, New York in 1779, served about 9 months as a private, officers not stated, and was in General Sullivan's Indian Expedition. He enlisted in 1780 and served 3 months, officers not stated. He died March 15, 1798.

Soldier married in Spencer, New York, September 12 or 13, 1782, Hannah Mack who was born December 10, 1763. She was allowed pension on her application executed December 29, 1836, while a resident of Harpersfield Township, Ashtabula County, Ohio.

Their children were:

Obidah born July 5, 1784.

Abigail born August 24, 1786.

David born July 5, 1788.

Daniel born July 15 or 17, 1790.

Reuben, Junior born April 29, 1792.

Caleb born April 24, 1794.

Hannah born December 22, 1798.

There is no further data as to family.
