

### Pension Application for Caleb Brewster

S.28367

B.L.Wt.172-200 Capt. Lieut of Col. Lamb's Regt Arty. Is sued Dec. 15, 1790.

Note: not much information in this file.

The list of pensioners printed in 1835 shows on list of invalid pensioners of New York, County.

Caleb Brewster, Lieut, U.S. Army, placed on pension roll Nov. 3, 1783 under act Aug 11, 1790, annual allowance \$200, increased to \$204 from Apr 28, 1820 under Act of Apr. 24, 1820, and died Feb. 13, 1827.

See Heitman Page 119, also see pension claim of Joshua Davis N.Y. W. 17698, there are two affidavits in it made by Capt. Caleb Brewster.

House Rep. April 25<sup>th</sup> 1820

Sir, Your note of yesterday has been handed me this morning.

I presume you do not entirely apprehend the object of Capt. Caleb Brewster. He is now on the pension roll as an invalid, and as I understand, never had a certificate and now asks that a certificate be issued to him, on the evidence that his disability continues herewith [?] him to father trouble & delay.
