

Disability for Thomas Brooks

Disability

His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court of the District of New York, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War, on May 22, 1794, and printed in the American State Papers, Class 7, page 126.

Rank: Private

Regt: Colonel VanCortland

Disability: Wounded in his right knee by a musket ball received from the enemy.

When and where disabled: September 7, 1777, Behmis' Heights.

Resident: West Chester County.

Remarks, Enlisted June 2, 1777, for war; on the rolls in 1782.
