

**Pension Application for Isaiah Burch**

On this eleventh of May in the year one thousand eight hundred & eighteen before James Emott first judge of Dutchess County came Isaiah Burch and on oath declared that he is a citizen of the United States and that he resides in the town of Beekman in Dutchess County aforesaid; that in or about the month of May in the year one thousand seven hundred & eighty two he enlisted for during the war between this country and Great Britain in the American Army in the First New York Regiment commanded by Collo VanSchaick and served as a soldier in such regiment for one year and until the eighth day of June in the year one thousand seven hundred & eighty three when he was discharged as appeared by his discharge hereunto annexed, and that by reason of his reduced circumstances in lfie he is [in] need of assistance from his country for support wherefore he claims the benefit of the act of Congress providing for the poor soldiers of the revolution.
