

**Pension Application for John D. Bush**

W.21733 (Widow: Sarah) Married August 14, 1784 to Sarah Halstead. John died at Fishkill September 9, 1824.

John D. Bush of the town of FishKill aged sixty three years being duly sworn deposes & says that he enlisted in the month of April one thousand seven hundred & eighty two in the Continental Army of the United States in the Continental Army of the United States in the Regiment commanded by Col. VanCortlandt in the N. York line of the Revolutionary Army in the company commanded by Lt Johnson & ensign Carpenter that his said enlistment was for the term of nine months that he did serve the said nine months in the Continental Army during the revolutionary war & that he was discharged at the expiration of his enlistment at Jonake Hills in the State of N. York in the month of January one thousand seven hundred & eighty three, that he has lost his discharge, that he is in such reduced circumstances as to require the assistance of his country for his support.
