

Pension Application for Alexander Camron

Personally came before me Lewis Condict one of the Judges of the Inferior Court of Common Pleas in and for the said County of M9orris, Alexander Camron, who being duly sworn deposeth and saith, that he was engaged in the service of the United States in the Revolutionary War, against the common enemy, on the Continental establishment.

That he first enlisted as a private soldier at Salem in the State of New York (for six months) some time in the month of June of the year seventeen hundred and seventy five in Captain Joseph Benedict's Company of the fourth Regiment commanded by Col. Holmes of the New York line, and continued in the said company & Regiment until the 31st day of December of the same year, when the said Regiment was disbanded at Salem afs'd.

That he afterward, to wit, on the first day of March in the year seventeen hundred and seventy six at Salem aforesaid enlisted for nine months as a Sargeant [sergeant] in Capt. Cornelius Steenrod's Company of the first Regiment commanded by Col. McDougall of the New York line, that he continued in the same of the said company and Regiment until the 31st day of December of the same year, at which time he rec'd a regular honorable discharge from the army from the said Col. McDougall; which discharge is now lost—

This deponent further saith that he resides near Morristown in the County of Morris & State of New Jersey; that he has never heretofore received any pension from the United States; and that from his reduced circumstances he needs the assistance of his country for support and prays to have his name placed on the pension list under the act of Congress passed the 18 March 1818 Entitled "and act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the revolutionary war".

This deponent further saith that he knows no person now alive who would be able to corroborate the facts set forth by him, but that the same are correct and true. (Signed)Alex'er Camron
