

Pension Application for James McCue

W.24146 (Widow: Angelica) James died February 28, 1804.

On this thirteenth day of May 1837, personally appeared before me Samuel W. Jones First Judge of the Court of Common Pleas in and for the County of Schenectada Angelica McCue a resident of the town of Rotterdam in the county of Schenectada and State of New York, aged eighty three years, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth on her oath, make the following declaration, in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the act of Congress, passed July 4, 1836: That she is the widow of James McCue deceased who was a private in the Militia & in the Quarter Master Generals' Department in said state, as particularly set forth in the annexed affidavits.

She further declares that she was married to the said James McCue on the twenty third day of July, in the year seventeen hundred and seventy three; that her husband, the aforesaid James McCue, died on the 28th day of February 1804 and that she has remained a widow ever since that period, as will more fully appear by reference to the proof hereunto annexed.
