His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the District of New York, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on April 25, 1794, and printed in the American State Papers, class 9, page 92.

Rank: Sailor

Sloop: Mechas Liberty

Disability: Wounded in the leg in an action with a British tender.

When disabled: June, 1775.

Residence: Westfield.

Remarks: Evidence transmitted by the District Court complete.

Persons of this description never had a pension stipulated.
