I further declare that I have never received nor have any of his heirs a warrant for the Bounty Law promised to John Corrigil aforesaid on the part of the United States nor do I believe he or they ever received it or transferred his or their claim to it in any manner whatsoever.

Therefore know all men by these presents that I john Corrigil Junior aforesaid do hereby contribute and appoint the Rev'd Peter A. Overbagh of Saugerties in Ulster County my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name to demand and receive from the Secretary of War of the United States a warrant for the quantity of Land due to me and Samuel Corrigil, Sally Corrigil and Zachariah Corrigil the other Heirs at Law of John Corrigil aforesaid.
