

**Pension Application for John Crawford**

R.13434 (Ann Wood) Married March 28, 1805 in the Town of Ballston, County of Saratoga. John Crawford died Nov 25, 1844.

There doesn't seem to be a deposition by John Crawford in the file which details his service.

Letter in folder dated May 12, 1913, written in response to an inquiry.

In response to your letter dated the 6<sup>th</sup> and received the 7<sup>th</sup> instant, you are advised that the Revolutionary War records of this Bureau show that Warrant No. 110,339 for 160 acres of land, issued September 5, 1870, to Ann Crawford, on account of the services of her husband, John Crawford.

From the papers in the claim, it appears that he entered the service in 1778, and served as a Private, Captain Boughton's company, New York militia, date of discharge not stated.

Soldier was born September 21, 1760 and married March 28, 1805, at Ballston, Saratoga County, New York, Ann Wood, his second wife (name of first wife not stated). He died November 21, 1844, at Macomb, Macomb County, Michigan, and in 1869, she was ninety-six years old and resides in Cohocton, Steuben County New York. A son, Ira, was born January 20, 1806.

There is no further data relative to family.
