Michael Cross of the Town of Charlton in the County of Saratoga aforesaid being by me duly sworn declares on his oath.

That he this deponent enlisted a private soldier at the City of Albany in the Continental Establishment in the revolutionary war in the company commanded by Capt'n Gibber in the Congress Regiment commanded by Col. Moses Azon in the New York Line some time in the month of March in the year one thousand seven hundred & seventy seven for three years and that he this deponent served for that period faithfully, and continued in the service of his country in the war aforesaid during the continuance of the said war to the conclusion of the peace in the spring of one thousand seven hundred & eighty three and he this deponent was regularly & honorably discharged a New Windsor in the State of New York in the spring of the year 1783—and this deponent further saith that by reason of his reduced circumstances in life he is [in] need of assistance from his country for support, and this deponent further saith not.
