

**Pension Application for Joshua Davis**

W.17698 (Widow: Abigail) Married January 1<sup>ST</sup> 1783. Joshua died January 25, 1833.  
District of Connecticut SS.

On this 30<sup>th</sup> day of March AD 1818, Joshua Davis of the Town & County of Fairfield in said District before the Hon. Pierpoint Edwards Judge of the District Court for the District aforesaid on oath, declares that he entered the service of the United States in a company commanded by Samuel Sacket, in the 4<sup>th</sup> regiment of the New York Line, under the command of Col. Henry B. Livingston, in the month of November 1776, that he was at the capture of Burgoyne, and in the battle of Monmouth, & served in said regiment until the month of August 1778, when he was detached by one of Gen. Washington & placed under the command of Capt. Caleb Brewster, under whom he served to the termination of the revolutionary war & having enlisted to serve during said war, in June 1783 he received a discharge and in the hand of Gen. Washington, duly & legally authorized & registered, to which was annexed a certificate to which was annexed a certificate of a badge of merit for his faithful service, which discharge he has lost & cannot now produce. (Signed) Joshua Davis.
