Patrick Davis of the Town of Wallkill County and State aforesaid being duly sworn deposeth and saith that he served as a private soldier in the Army of the United States in the War of the Revolution till the end thereof. And this deponent further saith that he entered the service aforesaid in the Fall of the year one thousand seven hundred and seventy eight to serve during the war and this deponent further saith that he was honourably discharged on the eighth day of June in the year one thousand seven hundred and eighty three then belonging to the company under the command of captain Fowler in the then Second New York Regiment, the same company as first belonging to the fourth New York Regiment.

And this deponent further saith that he is the same person mentioned in the discharge hereunto annexed and further that he is in such indigent circumstances that he needs the assistance of his country for support. (Signed with his mark)
