

## **Pension Application for Aaron Day**

Tompkins County, SS.

On this twenty sixth day of January 1821 personally appeared in open court, being a Court of Common Pleas, holden in and for the said county, in said State, constituted a Court of Record, by the laws of said State, with power to hear, try and determine, all actions real, personal, and mixed, arising in the said county, and also all transitory actions, although the same many not have arisen within the said county, and with other powers, Aaron Day aged fifty six years, resident in the town of Ulysses in the said county, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth on his oath declare, that he served in the Revolutionary War as follows:

That he enlisted in the month of March 1779 at Claverack in the State of New York for the term of nine months in Col. Livingston's Regiment. That Captain Grey commanded the company which was in the Fourth New Your Regiment of Continental Troops. That he served his said term as a musician and was discharged at Morris Town in the year 1780, that his services or more particularly drawn in his declaration now on file in the War Office.

And I do, solemnly swear that I was a resident citizen of the United states on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1818, and that I have not since that time by gift, sale, or in any manner, disposed of my property; or any part thereof, with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of an act of congress, entitled "an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval services of the United States in the Revolutionary War", passed on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 12818; and that I have not, nor has any person in trust for me, any property or securities, contracts or debts due me, nor have I any other income than what s I contained in the schedule hereunto annexed and by me subscribed.

That I have a wife to support who is aged and is much trouble with the [Phthinc?] I am also much unwell and generally in ill health that he is unable to support himself without his pension. (Signed) Aaron Day.
