

### **Disability Claim for Matthias Decamp**

NY Residence

Letter in file dated May 9, 1927, written in response to an inquiry.

I have to advise you that in the report from the Secretary of War in relation to the pension establishment of the United States, published in 1825, on the list of invalid pensioners inscribed on the roll of the New York Agency appears the name of MATTHIAS DECAMP. He served as a private in the Army of the Revolution and received an invalid pension at the rate of \$60 per annum. He died July 1, 1813.

There are no further data on file relative to said pensioner and nothing relative to his family owing to the destruction of papers when the war office was burned in 1800 and 1814.
