On this day the 28 of October 1854 personally came before Robert Rutan of the State of New Jersey Peter Decker age 92 years Resident of the County of Passaic and State of New Jersey who first being duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefits of the Provisions of the Act of Congress passed June 7<sup>th</sup> 1832 granting pensions to persons that served the country in the War of the Revolution, that he said Peter Decker is the Identical Person that served as a Private in the Regiment Commanded by Col. Duboice under Genl Haythorn he volunteered in the state of New York and served in the State of Virginia and other states from 1781 until the close of the war.
