

Pension Application for Jacob H. Diefendorff

Personally appeared before me, the undersigned, a Justice of the Peace of said County Jacob H. Diefendorff, who being duly sworn, deposeth and saith, that by reason of old age, and the consequent loss of memory, he cannot swear positively as to the precise length of his services, but, according to the best of his recollection, he served not less than the periods mentioned below and in the following grades. For seven days I served as a substitute for one James Wilson in Colo Clyde's Regt in the year 1779 the service was as a private soldier. For two days I served as private soldier. For then days I served as a private in the same Regt in the same year.

For the months I served in the same Regt as a fifer in 1780.

And for six months I served with same Regt as a fifer in 1781—and for such service I claim a pension. (Signed) Jacob H. Diefendorff
