

Disability Papers for Jacob Dieffendorph

His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the District of New York, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on December 31, 1794 and printed in the American State Papers, class 9, page 145.

Rank: Lieutenant

Regt: Capt. Henry Dieffendorph's

Disability: Wounded in his left foot by the accidental discharge of a musket.

When and where disabled: 1775

Residence: Connajoharrie

Remarks: Militia

Evidence: totally incomplete
