

Pension Application for John Dill

On this eighteenth day of June AD 1832 before me the subscriber first Judge of the Court of Common Pleas in and for the County of Cayuga and state aforesaid personally appears John Dill aged seventy four years resident in the town of Camillus in the County of Onondaga and state aforesaid who being by me first duly sworn according to law, doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provisions made by a late act of Congress entitled "An act supplementary to the act for the relief of the surviving officers and soldier of the Revolution."

That he the said John Dill enlisted in the town of New Windsor in the County of - - - in the State of New York in the company of artificiers commanded by Captain James Young in the Regiment commanded by Col. Baldwin (1) about the month of December AD 1777 or the month of January AD 1778. That he continued to serve in said company or in the service of the United States until the expiration of three years from the time of said enlistment when he was discharged at the town of Fish Kill in the County of Dutchess in the State aforesaid, that the said company was commanded by Capt. --- Purdy (2) after the command thereof was relinquished by Capt. James Young (3), that subsequently said company was commanded by Captain John Shepherd (4) who continued in command of said company when he said Dill was discharged—that he has no other proof of his said services except the following affidavit of Caleb W. Adams. (Signed) John Dill

1. Jeduthan Baldwin served as a Colonel of Artillery Artificer Regiment from September 3, 1776 to March 29, 1781.
2. Monmouth Purdy was appointed Captain in Colonel Baldwin's regiment on April 12, 1778 and he retired in March of 1781.
3. James Young was appointed Captain in Colonel Baldwin's Regiment on August 1, 1777 and he served until 1780.
4. John Shephard was appointed Captain in Colonel Baldwin's Regiment on November 24, 1779 and he served until he retired in March 1781.
