Personally appeared before me the subscriber a Justice of the peace in and for said County Robert Ditcher a resident of York in Pennsylvania who being by me duly sworn according to law that he entered the service of the United States in 1776 to the best of his recollection in the State of New Jersey and was shortly after qualified at Philadelphia and attached to Captain Lee's company in the Regiment commanded by Col. Lamb of the Artillery of N. York line and that he served the most part of the Revolutionary War and was in several battles and wounded several times and was discharged for disability on or about the year 1781 or 2—and that the Honourable [?] King of York Pa now a member of congress presented his petition to Congress for a pension. And that his present place of abode is York Pa in further saith now. (Signed with his mark) Robert Ditcher
