I John Devine of said County do declare and swear, that I entered the service of the United States in the War of the Revolution in 1780 or 1781, that I first served 8 months under Capt. White in Coll'n Willet's Regt on the frontiers in the State of Nw York. –That I then enlisted under Capt. Rose in Coll'n Pauldings Regt and continued with him to the close of the war, when I was discharged by the said Capt. Rose at Fort Plain on the Mohawk River, State of New York.

That any discharge has long since been worn out & lost, and that I am in such reduced circumstances as to stand in need of assistance from my country for support. (Signed with his mark) John Devine
