

**Pension Application for Elias Doughty**

The Declaration of Elias Doughty of the town of Beekman in the County aforesaid taken before me Daniel C. Verplanck one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid.

The said Elias being duly sworn deposes & says that he is sixty ;nine years of age that in the year one thousand seven hundred & seventy six he enlisted in captain William Forbes' company of Col Alexander McDougall regiment in the N York line of the Continental Army in the month of March about the beginning of the month & continued to serve against the common enemy until the month of November when he was discharged on account of ill health that he inlisted again in the ;month of April one thousand eight hundred eighty two in the company of Captain James Johnson in Col. Philip VanCortlandt's Regiment of the N York Line of the continental army continued to serve against the Common Enemy until he was discharged with the rest of the army in June one thousand seven hundred eighty three that he has lost his discharge that he is in reduced circumstances & required the assistance of his country for his support.
