

Pension Application for Enoch Eaton

On this 31st day of July A.D. 1832 personally appeared in open Court before the Judge of Probate Court of Rutland District now sitting, Enoch Eaton a resident of the County of Rutland District now sitting, Enoch Eaton a resident of the County of Rutland and State of Vermont, aged 68 years, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth on his oath make the following declaration, in order to obtain the benefit of the act of Congress, passed June 7, 1832.

That he entered the service of the United States under the following named officers, and served as herein stated.

In the year 1779 he resided at Hartford now in the County of Windsor Vermont, and lived with John Bennett; his [Bevetts?] was drafted to serve in the Militia and garrison the Fort at Betheland this deponent took his place and immediately enlisted or engaged to serve six months in Capt Benjamin's Company, Lieut he cannot recollect his name but he remembers very well how he looked, Orderly Sergeant, Emmerson, and he served at Bethel Fort six months when he was discharged some time in December 1779. He did not receive a written discharge, he as afterwards out a few days when [Royalten?] was burnt and at another time was called out on alarm and started for Newburgh was out on alarm and started for Newbury, was out a few days. He has no evidence of his services and knows of no person by whom he can prove them, he was born in East Windsor County of Hartford & State of Connecticut on the 1st day of November 1763—his birth is recorded there. There were no troops except said Company at the Fort when he was there he removed to East Windsor Conn, soon after the close of the Revolutionary War, and resided there until 41 years ago he removed to Castleton where he has resided ever since.

He hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension or annuity except the present, and declares that his name is not on the Pension roll of the Agency of any State. (Signed) Enoch Easton
