

### **Disability for Peter Felter**

Dis, Residence New York in 1794

Felter, Peter

His name appears on a list of Applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the District of New York, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on May 22, 1794, and printed in the American State Papers, Class 9, page 126.

Rank and Regt---

Disability: Acted as a guide to that part of the Army at the storming of Stony Point; and in the execution of that business, received a wound in one of his legs, for which he claims a gratuity, compensation having been promised him by General Wayne especially as the other guide employed in the same service, though not wounded, received a considerable gratuity.

Remarks: No evidence transmitted but Felter's own deposition.
