

Pension Application for Alexander Ferrioll or Ferriol

At a Court of Common Pleas holden at the Court-House in Plattsburgh, in and for the County of Clinton, and State of New-York, on the seventeenth day of January 1821. Present: Caleb Nicholas, Levi Pluts, Nathan Carver, Allen R. Moore. Judges of the said Court.

County of Clinton SS.

On this seventeenth day of January 1821, personally appeared in open Court, it being a Court of Record proceeding according to the course of the common law, and having the power of fine and imprisonment, and keeping record of their proceedings in and for the County of Clinton, Alsexander Ferriol aged fifty six years resident in the town of Chazy in the said County of Clinton , who being first duly sworn according to law; doth on his oath declare that he served in the revolutionary war as follows: That he joined the American Army on their retreat from Canada in June 1776 as a volunteer & in the fall of 1776 he enlisted at Albany in Capt. Oliver's company in Col. Hazen's Regiment called the Congress own Regiment for pursuing the war of the Revolution he was at that time Discharged and his original Discharge accompanied his application for a pension that he was in the battles of Brandywine Germantown Brunswick and Yorktown.

That his original declaration to obtain a pension under the Act of Congress of the 18th of March 1818 was made the twenty third day of April 1818, that he has received a pension certificate Numbered 910 and dated the sixth day of June 1818.

And I do solemnly swear that I was a resident citizen of the United States on the 18th day of March 1818 and that I have not since that time by gift sale, or in any manner disposed of my property or any part thereof, with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of an act of Congress, entitled "An act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and navel service of the United States in the revolutionary war", passed on the 18th day of March 1818 and that I have not nor has any persons in trust for me any property or securities, contracts or debts due to me, nor have I any income, other than what is contained in the schedule, thereto annexed, and by me subscribed.
