

### **Pension Application for Daniel Flannegan**

Disability

Flannegan, Daniel

His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the District of New York, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on April 25, 1794, and printed in the American State Papers, Class 9, Page 93.

Rank: Private

Regt: Col. Dubois's

Disability: Wounded in the knee whilst quelling a riot in winter quarters.

When and where disabled: Decem. 12, 1777, Newburgh.

Residence: Warwick.

Remarks: Physicians do not designate disability.

Enlisted Aug. 28, 1777; disch'd August 28, 1780.

Evidence transmitted by the District Court incomplete, viz: No examination of physicians. No evidence of his leaving the service.
