

Pension Application for Michael Fleming

On this fourteenth day of April one thousand eight hundred and eighteen before me the subscriber one of the Judges of the Circuit Court of the United States for the said district personally appears Michael Fleming aged seventy one years the sixteenth Day of November last resident in the township of Acquackanonk in the County of Essex the said District who being first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provision made by the late act of Congress entitled An Act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the revolutionary war.

That he the said Michael Fleming enlisted in the year one thousand seven hundred and seventy five as near as he can recollect in the month of July in the City of New York in the State of New York for six months in the company commanded by Capt. Johnson and continued to serve in said company for time of his enlistment and the [????] and that he again inlisted in the month of February in the year one thousand seven hundred and seventy six as near as he can recollect in the City [sic] of New York in the State of New York in the company commanded by Captain [Charrow?] belonging to the fourth York Ridgement [regiment] and continued in that service till near the close of the year—seventeen hundred and seventy six when stationed at [Scanesburry?] in Vermont when the said Michael Fleming when the said Michael Fleming inlisted for during the war in the s'd fourth ridgement commanded by Colonel Winecoop of Esopus in the State of New York and entered that service as Sergeant [Sergeant] Major and continued in that Ridgment til the first of the year seventeen hundred and seventy seven when an arrangement took place and the first, second, third and fourth ridgements were reduced to three ridgments when stationed at Albany in the State of New York when the said Michael Fleming was annexed to the first ridgment commanded by Colonel VanSchuck of Albany in the State of New York and continued in said first York Ridgment as Sergeant Major and orderly sergent during the war in the service of the United States until the year one thousand seven hundred and eighty three when he was discharged from service back of New Winsor in the State of New York that he was in the Battles of Munmoth and York town at the taking of Lord Cornwalles and that he is in reduced circumstances and stands in need of the assistance of his country for support and that he has no other evidence now in his power of his said service.
